

A Brief Introduction to the OUI

- Established 1974, based on the OU-UK model
- Open admission, distance learning (ODL), flexible
- 46,000 registered students in Israel & abroad (largest)
- ~ 700 courses, undergraduate and masters (no Ph.D.)
- Almost **4,000** graduates this year (2017-18) / small senior faculty (~100)
- Heavy reliance on educational technologies



The Open University mission

To enable access to a university degree to a wide segment of the population throughout Israel, irrespective of their previous achievements, but without compromising on high academic standards.

This goal will be achieved by innovative teaching methods incorporating advanced state-of-the-art technologies.

The OUI & the other universities: The Inter-accreditation tracks


- The OUI is a gate to the research universities in Israel. Agreements guarantee *a priori* accreditation of OUI courses.
- In particular, it enables students to take introductory level courses at the Open University and after accumulating credits in a cluster of courses, decide whether they would like to complete their degree at the Open University, or transfer to a research university.

The OUI Method



- The basic unit: <u>a course</u>.
- A student registers for each course independently.
- For a B.A./B.Sc. degree one should successfully complete 18-26 courses plus two seminar papers.
- The OUI has about 700 courses in various undergraduate & master's degree programs.
- Each course has been developed and is operated independently.

A Blended Learning Method



How does it work?

In every course:

- Study materials are delivered to the student by mail AND online.
- Students submit assignments throughout the semester.



Students may attend F2F tutorials in a regular or intensive format at 50 study centers throughout the country, or via technologies from their homes.


