





HSE-NES Bachelor of Arts in Economics



- Since 2011
 - 3 admissions, 63, 57 and 69 students;
- Four-year, full-time;
- 2 diplomas of the leading economic schools in Russia -HSE and NES;
- Academic exchange programs with the leading world universities;
- State-financed tuition waivers, dormitory is provided.



Master of Arts in Economics (MAE)





- Since 1992;
- Two-year, fulltime;
- 77 students (MAE'14) and 75 (MAE'15);
- Fundamental knowledge in economics;
- The core curriculum includes microeconomics, macroeconomics, econometrics, and English;
- Electives cover industrial organization, international trade, finance, economics of public sector, labor economics, etc.;
- State-financed tuition waivers, grants, loans and stipends.

New specialization: «Energy Economics and Natural Resources»



Objective: to train highly qualified specialists with a deep understanding of economics and a strong knowledge of the industry specifics.

- Number of students 30;
- Two-year, fulltime;
- Masters' degree.

Outcome: valuable human resources for the strategic development departments, economic, financial and analytical units of leading companies and organizations in the industry.



Masters in Finance





- Since 2007;
- 2 year, part-time;
- 35 students (MIF'14) and 33 (MIF'15);
- Designed for mid-career and high-career finance professionals;
- Focus on modern theory and practice of investments and corporate financial policy;
- The core financial curriculum (asset pricing, derivatives, corporate finance, M&A, risk management, etc.) are supplemented with courses on corporate management, macroeconomics, and econometrics.

Executive Education




- Since 2011

- A unique product for the Russian market – one-year executive education program in Russian;
- 500 top managers of Sberbank annually;
- Includes face-to-face sessions, distance learning, and independent study.

NES-HSE Joint Bachelor of Arts in Economics:


- ~ 80% of students accepted without entrance exams as winners and prize holders of Olympiads;
